

<b>Cloud point</b>	Temperature at which diesel starts to wax and become thicker
<b>viscosity</b>	Is a measure of diesel's ability to flow
<b>Self-ignition temperature</b>	Temperature at which diesel fuel will ignite without the aid of an external source
<b>Sulphur content</b>	Is a property of diesel that when combined with water produces an acid which corrodes engine components
<b>Energy content</b>	Is a measure of the heat produced from the fuel during burning
<b>Resistance to contamination</b>	Measures how effective the diesel fuel is at limiting the growth of harmful bacteria in the fuel tank
<b>flashpoint</b>	Temperature at which diesel will give off combustible fumes
