If a dog runs in front of you and you hit it you must contact the owner within 48 hrs

Under The Sales of Goods Act you can claim against a private seller or an unlicensed dealer if the car was stolen

Legally you do not have to inform the NZTA when you sell a car

The Motor Vehicle Sales Act applies to both licensed and unlicensed dealers

The Fair Trading Act makes it an offence to mislead a buyer about the vehicle

You may be fined 6 times the cost of the unpaid charges if driving a vehicle a vehicle without up to date road user charges

For failing to stop at a red light the fine is \$150

When selling a car you must fill in a notice of person selling a vehicle form

When buying a car you should always make sure the vehicle numbers (on chassis, firewall, dashpanel) match those on the vehicles ownership papers

When taking a vehicle permanently off the road you should remove the licence plates and hand them in to an NZTA agent
